The reason it took 2 weeks to recover was the fact that the opportunity to upgrade both hardware, software and relocate servers was taken.

"It's the economy, Stupid!" Remember that cry? It is the reason that after 30 years of retaining the company's mailing address as a post office box at the Port Townsend Post Office it is now changed to:

**P.O. Box 1439, Port Hadlock, WA 98339.** With Diesel fuel sitting about \$6+/gallon, my daily trip of 16 miles to get company mail has now come down to a 3 mile bicycle ride in good weather.



Please take note that your mailed invoice payments should now be sent to the new P.O. Box. Mail will be forwarded from Port Townsend to Port Hadlock for several weeks but, do change your "BillPay" automatic payment services to make sure they get to us.
