Sorry to be so late with this month's newsletter but, I just had to be certain that all our work in building our Fiber network to support our existing client network was in place and fully functioning.

At 11:25am this morning the big switch over for the Nordland area network was made from our WhidbeyTel over-the-water microwave link to the new Fiber system that connects us via NoaNet (PUD) fiber coming in from Seattle's Westin Building which is the NorthWest Nexus of the World's network.

No, this does not mean you all can go buy 4KTVs to stream Ultra High Def movies... We are still in the beautiful country not the big city.

But, it does mean that our Wireless clients on the east side facing Bush Point should have better service in the evenings as the load that our Nordland feed was putting on the Bush Point Microwave link is now gone. It does mean that all the Nordland and Griffith point clients will have better bandwidth. It finally means that the expansion projects we have been delaying can now move ahead. Not instantly but, carefully move ahead. I am sorry to not go into details here but, there are those folks on the Island that we are working with to expand to under served areas. Those folks can take this as good news and we appreciate their patience in waiting on us to complete network sections before we announce new coverage.
